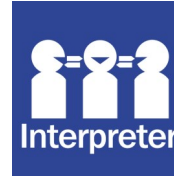

Carers Support Group

About the Carers Support Group

A carer is someone who gives their time to supporting another. The person being cared for could be a spouse or partner, family friend or extended family member.

The Carers Support Group is a gathering of carers to share experiences and learn from each other.

It is an opportunity to get to know other carers, discuss services, learn about new services, enjoy a meal or morning tea together, and feel part of the caring community.

Meeting times

The Carers Support Group meets on the second Wednesday of each month, usually from 10am at Neil Stewart House in Wangaratta, unless notified otherwise.

The group enjoys outings, discussions and information sessions related to their caring role.

Seminars, workshops and speakers can also be arranged as determined by the group.
