- We are committed to safeguarding children who we come in contact with from physical, sexual, emotional and psychological abuse and neglect.
- We inform children about their rights and what they can do if they feel unsafe or if something is worrying them. We will listen to and act on any concerns children or others may raise with us.
- We build the capacity of our people to recognise and respond to situations of abuse and neglect and to be aware of their responsibilities.
- All allegations of abuse will be treated very seriously.
- We have legal and moral obligations to contact authorities when we are worried about a child's safety.
- We support and respect all children, and are committed to the cultural safety of Aboriginal children, the cultural safety of children from a culturally and / or linguistically diverse backgrounds, and to providing a safe environment for children with a disability.
- Our organisation has robust human resources and recruitment practices for all staff and volunteers.
